2. Description of the Course

In a narrow sense, the capital market is a market (place, in the form of a building) which is prepared to trade stocks, bonds, and other types of securities using the services of securities brokers. The capital market is one way for companies to find sources of funds by selling company ownership rights to the public. Then the market for various long-term financial instruments that can be traded, both in the form of debt and equity, whether issued by the government, public authorities, or private companies. One of the existing instruments is that securities traded in the capital market can be divided into debt securities and proprietary securities. Debt securities are generally known as bonds and ownership securities are known as shares.
